

How to get to Kalymnos

By airplane – There are daily direct flights by Olympic Air from Athens airport to Kalymnos or to the nearest airport in the island of Kos. On arrival at Kos airport go to the Port of Mastihari and from there take the ferry, it takes 20'-30' to get to Pothia, the capital of Kalymnos. Charter flights direct to Kos are available from many European cities. The other option is to take a charter flight to Rhodes and from there to take a ferry, hydrofoil or catamaran direct to Kalymnos.

By ferry boat – Travel direct to Kalymnos by ferry from Piraeus, the port of Athens, it takes about 10 - 12 hours. The journey from Mandraki port of Rhodes takes about 5 hours by ferry and about 2 1/2 hours by hydrofoil or catamaran.
